HARDSHIP/POVERTY EXEMPTION INCOME GUIDELINES

Hardship Exemption applicants must not exceed the maximum total income per Family/Household as stated below.

Size of Family/Household (persons)	Maximum Total Income
1	\$10,800
2	\$14,600
3	\$18,300
4	\$22,100
5	\$25,800
6	\$29,500
7	\$33,300
8	\$37,000
Each additional	\$3,700

Note: The township board may adopt maximum income levels higher than the Federal Poverty Guidelines, making it easier for a Family/Household to be eligible for the Hardship Exemption.

It shall not adopt lower income levels thereby raising the standard for a Hardship Exemption.

For example, the Saugatuck Township Board may adopt the maximum total income level higher than \$18,300 for a Family/Household of 3 persons. But shall not lower any maximum total below what is shown above. A maximum total income of a Family/Household of 3 persons shall not be set lower than \$18,300.

HARDSHIP EXEMPTION ASSET GUIDELINES

Hardship/Poverty Exemption applicants may own one car but shall list any additional vehicles, boats, and any other real estate not included in the applicants Principal Residence.

Liabilities of applicants must exceed their assets, and their net income must be equal to or less than their expenditures.
