Saugatuck Township “Return-to-Work” Transition

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE – (Saugatuck Township, Allegan County, Michigan) June 2, 2020 – On Monday, June 1, 2020, Gov. Whitmer issued [Executive Order 2020-110](#), which ended the requirement to stay home and moved the State of Michigan to Stage 4 of the [MI Safe Start Plan](#). Accordingly, Saugatuck Township will begin its “return-to-work” transition.

To exercise an abundance of caution, the Township Hall will remain closed to the public through June 12. During this time, all customer service requests will continue to be handled via remote telephone or email correspondence. Please call 269-857-7721 or email info@saugatucktownship.org; staff will be glad to assist you. If you call the office, please leave a voicemail. The voicemail box will be checked regularly.

Beginning on June 8, staff will transition back to working from the office to prepare workspaces, participate in workplace safety training, and begin to catch-up on the backlog of in-person work. Starting on June 15, the Township Hall will open to the public with restrictions (i.e. safety precautions) that will continue to be in effect for the foreseeable future. These restrictions include but are not limited to:

- Township Hall restrooms will be closed to the public;
- Meetings with staff will be by appointment only;
- Individuals medically able to tolerate wearing a mask and/or face covering will be encouraged to do so; and
- Township Hall meeting spaces will not be available for rent and/or non-township-related business.

Saugatuck Township will continue to evaluate options for office operations and public meetings as additional information and further guidance is provided by the state. Please visit www.saugatucktownship.org for updates. Additionally, the Township’s COVID-19 Response and Preparedness Plan is available to the public by request.
