The purpose of the public hearing is to obtain public input from community stakeholders and consider adoption of a Resolution of Support of Saugatuck Township non-motorized trail development grant applications to the MDNR Trust Fund Development Fund in the amount of \$200,000 and the MDOT Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) in the amount of \$315,000 entitled “North Connections of The Blue Star Trail” to extend an existing portion of non-motorized trail along Blue Star Highway from Old Allegan Road thence south to Maple Street located in Section 10 of Saugatuck Township for approximately 0.25 mile; and also to extend an existing portion of non-motorized trail along Blue Star Highway from the corner of North Street thence west and north for approximately 0.25 mile through publically owned property in Section 3 of Saugatuck Township, thence west to the corner of Holland Street and Cemetery Road in Section 4 of Saugatuck Township.

The Saugatuck Township Parks Commission Resolution of Support and non-motorized trail development grant applications to the MDNR Trust Fund Development Fund and MDOT TAP entitled “North Connections of The Blue Star Trail” are available for review at the Saugatuck Township Hall, 3461 Blue Star Highway, Saugatuck, MI 49453. All community stakeholders of non-motorized trails and members of the public are encouraged to attend this public hearing and provide input and public comment regarding both the Parks Commission Resolution of Support and Saugatuck Township development grant applications to the MDNR Trust Fund Development Fund and MDOT TAP.
