



Summer 2022 Important News and Information from the Treasurer

- We recommend that you mail in your tax payments. Due in the office by September 14, 2022.

- Payments by check or money order can be left in a drop box at the office or in the Drop Slot in the front door when office is closed.

- Credit card payments are accepted **ONLY** on our website -- **SAUGATUCKTOWNSHIP.ORG** Choose the Payment option in the bar at top of the screen. Select the Local Payment box, then Michigan, Saugatuck Township, and taxes on the **right** side of screen. There is a 2.8% service charge added to your credit card by the servicing company which does not go to the Township.

- Cash payments should be exact as we cannot make change at the office. Money order or cashier's check preferred and encouraged.

- Receipts are not sent automatically as the top portion of your tax bill is considered a receipt. To receive a signed receipt, simply include a note with the mailing/email address to which you would like one sent.
